needs, free off-street covered parking with space for 35 vehicles, facilities to accommodate disabled persons, a drive-thru with four lanes and eight capsules, and extended business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on weekdays and 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The branch will also feature a night depository for business clients, a lobby depository for payments and deposits, and three ATMs in the ATH® network.

To supplement the offerings at the Main Office, Banco Popular has set up a new ATM located at 48B Norre Gade. Situated approximately 350 feet from the current Hibiscus Alley location, this ATM offers an alternative for cash withdrawals, account inquiries, and deposit services.
